Lynn McIntyre is currently Professor in the Department of Community Health Sciences, Faculty of Medicine, University of Calgary, Alberta, Canada. She joined the University of Calgary in July 2006 and holds a Canadian Institute of Health Research Chair in Gender and Health. Prior to coming to Calgary, Dr. McIntyre served three terms as Dean of the Faculty of Health Professions at Dalhousie University, Halifax, Nova Scotia. Dr. McIntyre's quantitative and qualitative research studies are focused upon hunger and food insecurity both domestically and in lower and middle income countries with an emphasis on poverty and women.
