## Biography

Olena Hankivsky, PhD – Associate Professor, Public Policy Program; Founder and Co-Director of the Institute for Critical Studies in Gender and Health at Simon Fraser University and Co-Leader Women’s Health Research Network.

Dr. Hankivsky’s research interests include gender and sex based analysis, intersectionality, economic costing, primary care and violence against women. She is co-editor of *Women’s Health in Canada: Critical Perspective on Theory and Policy* (University of Toronto Press, 2007) and editor of the forthcoming *Intersectionality Health Research in Canada* (University of British Columbia Press). In 2008, Dr. Hankivsky was awarded a Research Chair in New Perspectives in Gender and Health by the CIHR and a Senior Scholar Career Award in Population Health by the Michael Smith Foundation for Health Research.
